ATTENDEES ELIGIBILITY

All Applicants must have a current AGU handicap and be a financial member of their respective state organisations and meet the eligibility criteria as defined by the ACGA Rules and state committee. These Rules will determine order of entry in the event of over subscription. State secretaries will liaise to ensure these rules are fairly adhered to

FORMAT FOR EACH GOLFING DAY

For all five golf days there will be split shotgun starts – **AM & PM**. All participants will be given the option to nominate which they prefer **and** every endeavour will be made to meet these preferences, but ultimately discretion will lie with the host state.

CAPITATION FEE

The Capitation fee has been set by the Committee at **\$1,500 (inc GST)** per member. This fee is payable with your application and excludes accommodation, private functions and drinks (except those assigned to certain ACGA functions)
